

I am an oceanography PhD student and have found this book to be very helpful in learning to identify zooplankton. The extreme diversity of plankton makes it difficult to create a broad guide, but the authors of this book have managed to touch on all of the different groups while maintaining scientific accuracy. In addition to information about each species, there are recommended readings at the end of each chapter for those who want to learn about the species groups in more detail. The book also contains information on capturing and preserving plankton, which is ideal for any educator. I cannot recommend this book enough for someone who is just getting interested in biological oceanography. However, the extensive scientific references throughout the text will keep even an experienced plankton biologist referencing this book for years to come.

This book is great for the beginner looking to learn about how to ID taxonomy. It is in no way comprehensive, so if you're looking for a book to ID a particular species you may or may not be out of luck. However, it is a wonderful starting guide to get you on the right track.
