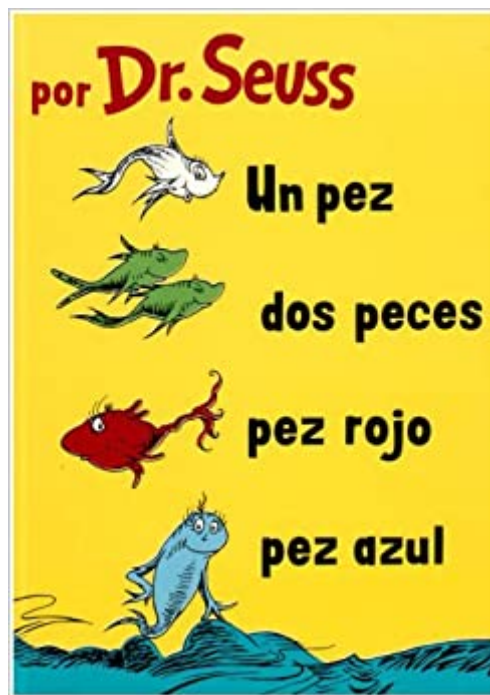

Dr. Seuss was born Theodor Geisel in Springfield, Massachusetts on March 2, 1904. After attending Dartmouth College and Oxford University, he began a career in advertising. His advertising cartoons, featuring Quick, Henry, the Flit!, appeared in several leading American magazines. Dr. Seuss's first children's book, *And To Think That I Saw It On Mulberry Street*, hit the market in 1937, and the world of children's literature was changed forever! In 1957, Seuss's *The Cat in the Hat*

became the prototype for one of Random House's best-selling series, Beginner Books. This popular series combined engaging stories with outrageous illustrations and playful sounds to teach basic reading skills. Brilliant, playful, and always respectful of children, Dr. Seuss charmed his way into the consciousness of four generations of youngsters and parents. In the process, he helped kids learn to read. Winner of the Pulitzer Prize in 1984 and three Academy Awards, Seuss was the author and illustrator of 44 children's books, some of which have been made into audiocassettes, animated television specials, and videos for children of all ages. Even after his death in 1991, Dr. Seuss continues to be the best-selling author of children's books in the world.

Excellent translation. It rhymes and very well. My son (5) was reading it everyday on his own for about 3 months once he got through it the first time. The translation is excellent, almost as compelling as the English version. That says a lot when it comes to Dr Seuss books. I've started to look for other books translated by Yanitzia Canetti. She certainly earned her keep with this one. If you like it, try "Yoruga La Tortuga" translated by the same lady. It also comes as close to the original English version as Dr Seuss would have wanted.

I love dr.Seuss now! I thought the translations wouldn't work, but they are great! It all makes perfect sense (Im native speaker of Spanish) and I love the rhythm, the rhymes, and games with words.... And this particular book I think could be great for people with a smaller command of Spanish because it has very basic words and phrases, it starts with things like "big fish, small fish, tall fish, short fish, fat fish, thin fish, this fish has a star, this fish has a hat, the fat fish has a cat...." which going together with the drawing of the fish, is a great way to learn basic Spanish words!! totally recommend for anybody :)
