

I purchased this to help study for the registry. Unfortunately some of the question/answers are out of order. And some of the answers just plain wrong! For instance, SAR, on question 169, is specific absorbtion rate, NOT, susceptibility attack region as the answer states. If this was the only study guide I was using, that type of miss matches would really screw me up. I know that this guide is coming out in print in June 2013, hopefully this will have been caught. If not, buyer beware. Luckily I

have been through an MRI course and am not just using this review. If you haven't, please invest in more study materials than just this guide. All in all, this could be much better, however I think it is the editing and not Ms Roth that is at fault. The information is present, it just seems to have gotten a bit jumbled.

This book did help with in my studying for the ARRT MRI registry in January 2017. But it was not my only source for studying. I also used Mrs. Roth's online program which was the biggest help (ImagingEd.com) and I also attended her Registry review program that highlighted info from her online program. She and her crew have done an excellent job of providing my in-depth knowledge for MRI.

I'm on the verge of taking ARRT registry exam...I purchased this book thinking it would help me to prepare, but, it has been more frustrating! I did catch the errors because I have numerous of other material to study from. But, considering how many the questions this book has it's not worth the time to go every single one. Especially, the ones you don't know the answers too. Don't waste your time on purchasing the book, and may I add money.

I have now purchased the ad version and the book itself but they both contain the same mistakes. I don't think that anyone proof read the book before it was published. Answers are misnumbered and just plain wrong answers are given. It's not very helpful when you are trying to study for the MRI boards. I have now spent \$100 for both and still are looking up the correct answers. Not a review book from these two authors I expected to get.

I haven't reviewed the whole book, however the questions I have reviewed I really question if the people who wrote this book really knew what they are talking about. I'm afraid to use this as a study guide because I'm not sure if the answers to the question are really correct. I have been looking mostly at the anatomy questions. In "imaging procedures" question 293. What is "e" pointing to? It's the right adrenal gland...NOT the left. Also in "Imaging procedures" questions 507,508,509 are asking what "a" is each answer is different. These are just a few. I'm sorry I purchased this book.

proofreading it would have been high on my to do list before I published it. if that wasn't enough, flipping from the questions to the back of the book for answers that had no explanations for most, not really a good use of time.
