

Craig Hartman is the director of Shalom Ministries Inc. based in New York City and a well-known speaker at conferences and churches across the country. He holds a law degree from New York University and a master's degree from The Jewish Theological Seminary.

This book took my understanding and knowledge of the Jewish history and influences in the New Testament, and the Jews as a people, and how to reach them for the Gospel way beyond what I had previously learned in Bible college and in decades of teaching and preaching in Bible-believing churches. It is one thing to have these things explained by a non-Jew and another to have a Jew explain them himself in a well-researched and heartfelt exposition. I look forward to more from this author.

We had the author of this book speak at our church. He brought books to sell but ran out of them

quickly. Hartman, who was born Jewish, brings to the table an understanding of scripture that would take the average Christian many years of directed study to attain. As Christians we do ourselves a great disservice if we neglect the inherent "Jewishness" of the book we hold so dear. The authors practical understanding of scripture, keen wit and great sense of humor make this a very easy read. I recommend this work to any and everyone who has an interest in strengthening their walk with Christ.

Dr Craig Hartman has written an excellent layman's guide to the Jewish perspective on Scripture, including the significance of many Jewish traditions to Christians today. He raises many questions and topics appropriate for further study. I would highly recommend that every Messianic Jewish person and Gentile Christian read this book. It will enhance all future Bible study and would be extremely useful to read prior to a trip to the Holy Land.

Some information, such as the various feasts, etc., may not be exciting reading to some, but is useful when needed. For example, the apostle Peter has always been criticized for asking the Lord if they should make 3 tabernacles on the Mt. of Transfiguration. Hartman explains that Peter knew what he was speaking about but his timing was wrong.

I chose to give 5 stars because Craig Hartman obviously knows well what he is talking about, and I appreciate being able to learn some of these things from him. This book had been recommended to me by a friend, and it fully met my expectations.
