

Taking the time to find out why you dislike someone the first time you meet him turns out to be a pretty good idea. Especially when you're generally easygoing and open, making friends quickly. John and Matt don't hit it off at first but, when put together for the summer, both are willing to talk, to give the other person a chance to be more than they assumed. And both men find themselves challenging their initial conclusions. As they begin looking for different motives, they find strong, likeable personalities in the other. That unique openness of character and direct dialog, makes this a charming and fun story. I liked this book a lot. France. Villa. Views. Fun. Romance. Conversation. What is not to like? It is written in first person present tense, which is a bit unusual and not my preferred style. However, the only problem I had with this book was the lack of commas. Yes, the lowly comma changed this from a five to four star for me. I decided some of this unusual problem was cultural but a lot of it is just bad grammar. When writing in first person present, addressing someone becomes problematic when not offset with a comma. "Do you want to John?" "Do you want to, John?" are very different sentences. Even though a simplistic example, the lack of commas throughout the book made me re-read numerous sentences and even paragraphs. It was a distraction, at best.

I am now going to be a stalker fan of Mrs. Morton. I absolutely adore her writing style and dialogue. These two men just made my heart smile. There were so many memorable parts that make me just want to go back for a quick re-read. My husband even commented on the smile on my face. That's rare.
