

Clear, easy to play on the piano. Includes the sonnets in both the original Italian language and a translation to English. For the Late Intermediate- Advanced pianist (Europe Test grades- Advanced beginner- Intermediate). Most of the arrangements are good, but the majority are arranged in not Baroque but late classical and romantic style. Some are arranged as if a Baroque composer arrange them, though. The only transcription I don't really like is the Summer Storm (3rd Movement). Probably every arrangement of that movement I will not like. The piano is just not the right instrument. Also, "The Storm" is pretty hard to play without playing slowly for a while for me. Most of the others are easy to sightread but Autumn has a few very fast passages that I find difficult to sightread. Great book overall. Probably 1 out of 2 Vivaldi keyboard books I would want.
