

So far as fantasy story-telling goes, this story isn't radically different from a lot of what else you'd find in the fantasy market. It's a quit read, spaced out with quite a few pictures so the story is shorter than the page count would lead you to believe. There were few surprises, but still holds up.

A good children's story (for slightly older kids due to war theme though it is left unsaid). The art is lovely. The story to me has a theme of trusting your inner self and being true to oneself despite what parents or family or others may want you to be. It also reads like a fairy tale. Strange circumstances and hints of old folklore. I enjoyed it and enjoy sharing it with my 8 year old son who shares my love of dragons and of human and animal bonds.
