

Wobegon monologues. A Prairie Home Companion is heard on hundreds of public radio stations, as well as America One, the Armed Forces Networks, Sirius Satellite Radio, and via a live audio webcast. Keillor is also the author of several books and a frequent contributor to national publications including Time, The New Yorker, and National Geographic, in addition to writing his own syndicated column. He has been awarded a National Humanities Medal from the National Endowment of the Humanities. When not touring, he resides in St. Paul, Minnesota.

I have long enjoyed the PHC radio broadcasts, have attended one at Ravinia Pavillion, read several of his books and have sent his books as gifts. His Writer's Almanac used to make me almost late in arrival every morning at the office. The wide range of collected materal for PGJB will also appeal to a most wide audience, but not all to everybody. I have found if I read a section of puns, many most clever, it gets to be a bit much in a short period of time. Most will agree consuming a little chocolate is most pleasing. I suspect trying to eat a couple of pounds of even the world's gretest cholocate in a short period could be a real trial.

I don't know about anybody else but I have had a blast reading most of these jokes! Sure a lot of them are corny but if they make me laugh that is good. I have even read some to my 88 yo mom over the phone and she loved them!

I bought this for my 10 year old grandson - didn't realize it had some adults only jokes in it.....but it was fun to read!
