

The story is about one boys journey into manhood and how his culture plays a roll in going back to his ancestors and back to the truth of his own heritage. It is just an excellent read. The book was every bit as good as I remembered it to be when I was a kid.

I first read this in 7th grade and fell in love. It is the story of a Native American boy who undergoes a transformation from a traditional native living in harmony with nature and the land to a rodeo bull rider of great prowess. His journey is sometimes painful and sometimes blissful. It is a story that has stayed with me for decades and changed how I understood the plight of the Native Americans. It made me wear moccasins for 2 years and develop an interest in Native American flute music. Powerful story-telling, for sure.

I remember reading this in high school begrudgingly and then loving it. I am glad I was able to get it again. It has been more helpful than I ever realized.
