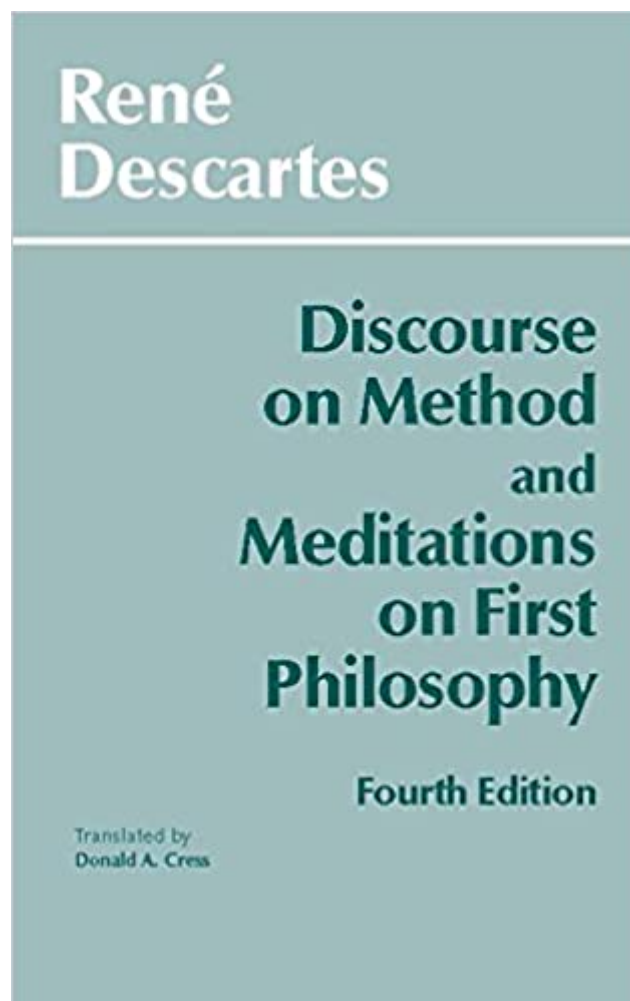


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# Discourse On Method And Meditations On First Philosophy, 4th Ed.
