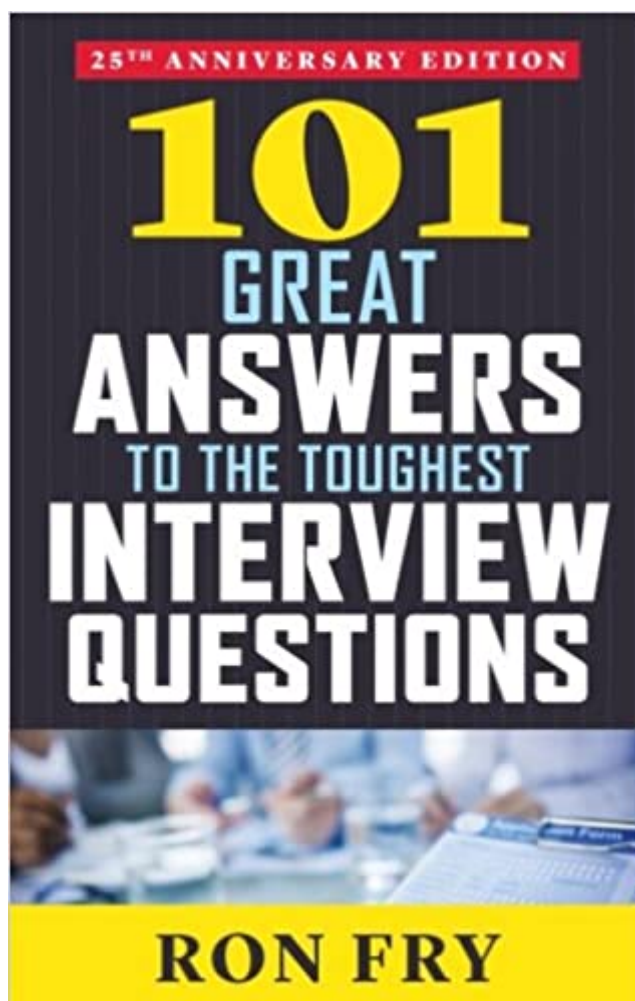




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101 Great Answers To The Toughest Interview Questions, 25th Anniversary Edition
