

I was surprised with the level of language - there's so much great writing in here. Don't just read the stories by the famous standouts - the lesser known writers in this anthology are so great and refreshing and exciting. I especially loved Lucius Shepard and Nancy Kress and Robert

Silverberg. A great book to read in small chunks. I also liked the chapter groupings - it was nice to have the option of which variety of apocalypse story I wanted to try with each sitting.
