

Howard Peskett is the UK Scholarships Administrator of the Langham Partnership International, a programme founded by John Stott, providing scholarships for Majority World students to do doctoral studies in various countries. Previously he worked in preaching, teaching and theological training in Singapore and East Asia with OMF International, and at Trinity College Bristol, where he was Vice Principal until 2006.

This is a good study...well written and the questions are pertinent to what we are studying. However, Mr. Peskett does not cover ALL of the chapters in the book of Isaiah in the study guide. For example, he covers Chapters 1 and 2, but skips chapters 3 and 4. This is the way it goes through out the entire study of Isaiah. Since our group wanted to study ALL of the chapters in Isaiah we decided to write our own summary of the missing chapters and share it in class. This has worked out well. That said I do like the way Mr. Peskett gives thought provoking questions, discussion questions and personal questions...quite a variety that our group likes. I would definitely do another study by him.

This is an outstanding study. The questions invoke great study and discussion. If you are seeking to learn and understand God's Word better, than this is a very useful tool for the task. As a group we have gained so much insight from one another and prayerfully you will too.

This LifeGuide Bible Study series is excellent. There are books like this one available on every book of the Bible. We just finished one on the book of James. It told us to read a chapter and then answer questions on the chapter of the Bible. It caused us to think about what the Bible is saying, and how it applies to our lives.

The prophesy God gave through Isaiah is not well-covered in this study if you are a premillennialist and don't prescribe to replacement theology. However, this study can be used as a starting point and then introducing these important truths as you work through the chapters.

We liked the format, the questions used as a guide and the chapters the study focused on. requires more words to write a review than I want to invest so I am going to stop writing reviews.

I feel the author must have been a former English teacher as the study questions were worded in such a way that a lot of people I. Our group could not understand what he was asking. I would not buy another book written by him.
