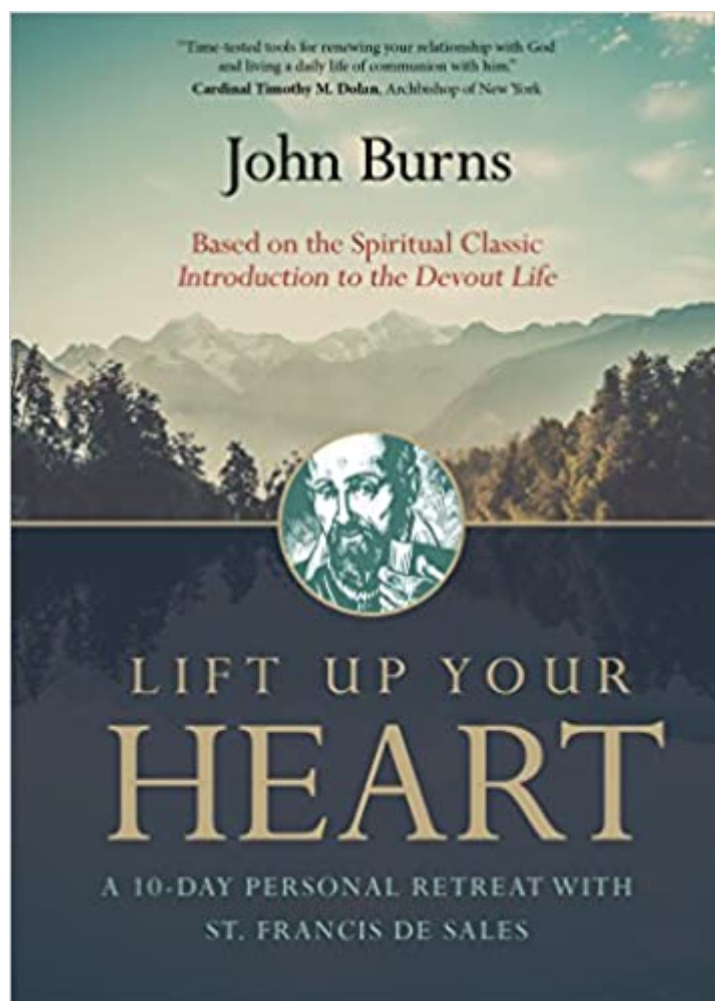


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Lift Up Your Heart: A 10-Day Personal Retreat With St. Francis De Sales

As you do so, you'll feel God's fatherly love and restart your faith life, equipped with the tools to connect with God and live for heaven now.

Rev. John Burns is pastor of St. Mary's Parish in Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin. A 2003 graduate of the University of Notre Dame, Fr. Burns studied theology at the Pontifical North American College in Rome. He was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee in 2010 and completed a licentiate in moral theology from the Pontifical University of Santa Croce in 2011. Fr. Burns is a speaker at Franciscan University of Steubenville's annual conferences, archdiocesan engaged enrichment conferences, and Theology on Tap. He works in multiple capacities with both the Men of Christ and Women of Christ annual conferences, and contributes to the young adult renewal ministries of ARISE and Cor Jesu. He also serves as adjunct professor of moral theology at Sacred Heart School of Theology in Hales Corners, Wisconsin. Fr. Burns is a regular guest on Relevant Radio's The Inner Life. He works extensively with Mother Teresa's sisters, the Missionaries of Charity, and has given retreats, conferences, and spiritual direction for the sisters in Romania, Armenia, Kenya, Italy, England, Spain, Portugal, and the United States.
