A little boy wakes up with a longing for pancakes, and his mom is busy and so directs him to get grain, have it milled, get milk from the cow, etc in order to make the pancake. This is a fairly long, detailed story that teaches kids where their food comes from through text and Carle's signature colorful artwork. I would recommend this for ages 3.5 on up. This is one of my four year old's favorite books, and he particularly loves learning about the grain being ground. This book is a great way for children to access the concept of farm to table. It's a bit long without much plot, but I've loved seeing how it has ignited my son's curiosity.

Font is kind of small, pictures are kind of small. It's like they took the big book and shrunk it for Hobbits. I wish I had gotten the regular sized book instead of this little version. For the children I wanted to use it with as part of my job, it has too many words, too.

I "read" this book to my kiddos before our Christmas pancake breakfast and then did a little math lesson as well. They LOVED it because they got to make up the story.
