This short prequel to the series about vengeance demons contains information about the background story of one of the most kind-hearted vengeance demons. Fast and engaging, we get to know Serafina's life before she was returned to the plane where vengeance demons lived, and the demands on her before and after the Crossover. Despite the harsh conditions of being an outcast first in the faerie world and then even in her own family, she has the strength to carry on and try to

help those who need it. Her warm heart, natural kindness and urge to help and protect make this sweet girl an adorable heroine, and I would love to see more of her actions and contribution in the next books.
