Synopsis

Its rapidly developing market economy stands as the second largest in the world after the United States, and hundreds of millions of its citizens have been lifted out of poverty. This book contains 127 pages of information on China. It was published in 2003, so some of the facts have been quickly outdated and those details concerning the year the information was obtained; percentages, etc should have been noted for the reader. It is listed as young adult, but I

would place it, at the highest, at a 10th grade subject level. It contains much information about the geography, the government and economy, some cultural, with not many pictures. The maps are problematic, some information is almost smudged and hard to discern because of the amount that is attempted to be included on the maps. The print on the maps is also very small. Even some of the pictures are not well explained, especially one showing an aerial view of rice paddies, with unexplained black splotches on the fields. Included are facts at a glance, a timeline and glossary, a list for further reading and a few internet addresses and an index. Many of the political problems are skipped over and there is almost no information at all about the lifestyles of the Chinese people themselves.
