

Other recreation features include trailheads, interpretive trails, campgrounds, RV campgrounds and dump stations, cross-country ski trails, alpine ski areas, boat ramps, canoe and fishing areas, lookout towers and scenic viewpoints. Every Trails Illustrated map is printed on "Backcountry Tough" waterproof, tear-resistant paper. A full UTM grid is printed on the map to aid with GPS navigation. Today, National Geographic Maps continues this mission by creating the world's best wall maps, recreation maps, atlases, and globes which inspire people to care about and explore their world.

I much prefer Sky Terrain Maps but there isn't one available for the Santa Fe/Truchas Peak area. This is, however, a very good trail map. I've hiked many of the trails listed on this NatGeo map and only have one complaint. Their trail mileage markers fall short (by a mile or more). I thought it was a GPS issue but verified it with other hikers. A Google search revealed that others have noted this issue as well with NatGeo maps.

I love the Trails Illustrated maps. The right level of detail for me. Distances between junctions, basic topo, campgrounds.

Great map. Better than any other map out there.

#### Great map

I have not found a better map for this area. It covers the Sangre de Cristo mountain immediately north of Santa Fe with great detail (That would include a great part of the Pecos Wilderness). If you are planning on some hikes around Santa Fe, check this map.

The map stops south of Truchas peak. You can't name a map after a peak and then not include the peak on the map.
