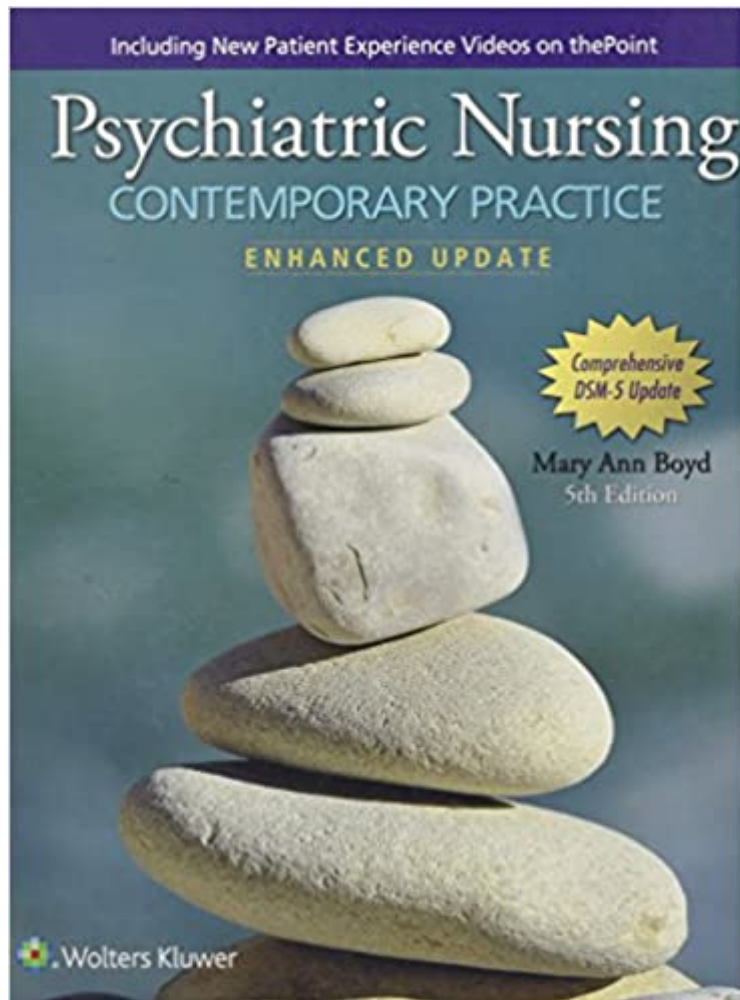

I have a BA in psychology and went back to school for nursing. This was our assigned textbook for our psych nursing class, and I have honestly never been less impressed with a, assigned book. I felt like the author just typed each disorder into Google scholar and wrote a sentence about each article without actually looking at the evidence behind them. Rather than go into the details of evidence based theories of neurobiological causes of psychiatric disorders, she tosses out a grab-bag of hypotheses that often contradict each other, or, with even the most rudimentary research, are shown to have been widely discredited through research. A similar problem is presented with statistics that contradict each other from chapter to chapter (in some instances, from sentence to

sentence). The changes for DSM 5 are minimal and seem to have been written before the DSM5 was published, meaning that there is a good amount of speculation about changes that "might" occur and never ended up taking place (and yes, due to an error, I ended up with the DSMV and DSMIVTR versions of this textbook). This book contains almost zero guidance on actual nursing interventions to help the mental health patient population. The "care plans" included are rudimentary and filled with typos. There is literally no mention of self-harm as anything but a suicidal or parasuicidal behavior. The only disorder that it is mentioned as a "symptom" of is borderline personality disorder. "coping skills" for patients are mentioned in the vaguest manner as something we should teach and model for our patients- but there are very few examples of actual, practical coping skills. Dual diagnoses are barely mentioned. I hope that professors will think twice about the misconceptions and stereotypes that this book has the potential to instill in their students. There are plenty of excellent resources for mental health nursing, and this is not one of them.

This textbook is nice in that it has a conversational tone and doesn't seem to make things too much more complicated than they need to be. I don't like how every disease is split up into biological, social, and psychiatric domains within the chapter--it makes it hard to find the info I need. The major reason this got such a low score is OH LORD THE TYPOS. They are awful, many sentences don't even make sense at all (as in you can't even figure out what the heck they mean), and there are misspellings galore. It makes it hard to understand concepts when half the sentences don't make any sense!
