

During this summer break, his homework is to study English as he is very good in math and artistic matters. He gets along with others and due to his quiet personality, he is not very conversational. I hope that this book will engage him and pump up his confidence and self esteem. This book is not very helpful for an ESL student, but also an English speaking student readying his/her self for the ACT or SAT.

A friend of mine from Morocco seemed sad that his English skills weren't quite good enough. I tried to bolster his self-esteem. "After all, you speak fluent French and Arabic. And your English is a bonus." I gave him this book so he could dig a little bit deeper into the English language. Then he showed it to his two teen-age daughters. He says the whole family loves the book. That's good enough for me. I gave the book 4 stars.

But what makes this book so great is that, a definition is not just presented like so many other word books or lists, but is told in a more user friendly tone, that helps the reader to gain a more insight into how the words should be preceived and used in certain situations.
