

"Anyone who has ever found themselves intimidated by a full-sized canvas or at loss as to what to fill a large painting surface with will be relieved to encounter this guide by artist Nelson. Fifty short exercises walk the reader through creating tiny five-inch square paintings of lots of different subject matter using a wide range of techniques. The small format can foster experimentation and learning, while the medium of acrylics is more immediate and easy to use than oils or watercolors. Most of the projects will take an hour or less to execute, and by the end of the book, a handsome body of

work will have been produced. After an introductory chapter on tools, materials, and basic techniques, subsequent chapters present exercises to familiarize the reader with acrylics, show how to represent space realistically, how to construct abstract compositions, and how to render form and surfaces. Each two-page project features a handy sidebar, which details the specific materials used, the exact shades included in the color palette, and notes other similar projects in the book.

Each painting teaches one small concept at a time and they are very accessible to new painters. To keep interest, there is a variety of eye-catching, fun subjects! Landscapes, still lifes, even a portrait in the advanced section. Very little preamble, most projects are "Grab your paints and go!" I have gotten more out of this book than many other beginning books, I already feel like a more confident acrylic painter in regards to lighting, color mixing, and composition.

I have always wanted to learn to paint, but as a busy mom I could never find the time. Taking a class seemed intimidating, considering I had barely picked up a brush. This book is perfect for teaching me the basics in short spurts that I can handle and I end with a finished product each time. An hour or two in the afternoon during nap time or a weekend morning gets me through at least 1-2 paintings. I have completed about 10 and can really see improvement. My children have even joined in the fun, trying to paint the scenes on their own paper. They never even seemed interested in art until I started working through this book and now they both want their own paints. I would recommend this to anyone wanting to learn or improve their skills in painting. It's so relaxing and fun and not intimidating because if you mess something up you can always try again. It's only a small painting, after all. After this book I may just sign up for that painting class!

This is something I'm looking forward to as a daily exercise on days when I'm not able to paint larger. Yes, it's good to come up with your own ideas but there are times when you just need a little push in the right direction. I like the simplicity of these which leaves the buyer room to stretch. Enjoy them how they are given or enhance to personal taste.

I am now on lesson 43 and I am having so much fun. If you want to learn to paint, I recommend this book. It takes you from a simple painting through with ever more complex paintings to a rather complex painting at lesson # 50. Along the way I have tried other similar paintings with the lessons to flex my painting muscles. It is fun and educational at the same time.

I can't say enough good things about this book. I've never thought of myself as an artist, but I caught the bug after doing a couple "paint and drink" nights with my friends. I wanted to get serious about painting things I love, and learning to paint acrylics on a small scale seemed the most economical and "doable." I'm past painting number 10 now and I am so pleased with my progress. I

know the paintings will get more intricate and probably more difficult, but I already feel empowered to go out on my own and paint other things at my leisure. I can't wait to display all my paintings together when they are done!

This was a good buy. I have been going to start painting with acrylics for years and this book started me off with a simple painting that started with paints straight out of the tube. No mixing. Each painting introduces a new lesson such as mixing different colors to make a new color. Each painting is another lesson on how to paint. Great concept.
