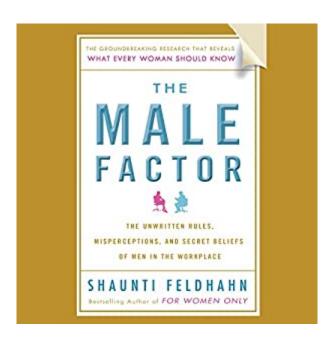

The workplace isn't limited to corporations with many employees. I own my own business and wondered if this would be helpful. It was! And it was eye-opening! I work on projects with men and this has helped tremendously with my confidence in speaking authoritatively in my area of expertise. I now know that my directness isn't offensive; it's helpful to male processing. I speak less about my children and personal life to connect with prospects (like women prefer to do). I'm more aware of dressing to be taken seriously. The explanation of how male and female brain structures differ was fascinating and provided me with a basis for understanding that men can't help their maleness any more than I can help my femaleness, but that awareness encourages flexibility.
