

The title captures it nicely--although I might modify it slightly to call the book a "highly satisfying mix." Rothberg blends the skills of memoirist, analyst, lecturer, and short story writer. She is an accomplished stylist, and the reader meets a person who not only informs but also challenges, amuses, and confirms--who is both gritty and sensitive. Not surprisingly, the organization is thoughtful and propulsive. A reading for organizational leaders, teachers, students (of all sorts), and, of course, those who appreciate a distinctive cocktail.

Professor Rothberg's THE PERFECT MIX should be required reading for those who are or will be in any management position. As Dr. Rothberg emphasized, management does not always demonstrate what true leadership should be; rather, good leadership involves intelligence, understanding of human emotions and practical actions that will further the company's goals and objectives. What Professor Rothberg offers us is a package of effective leadership experiences and skills, wrapped in real-life stories, not just from corporate executives but from the person who serves your drinks, food and their opinions. Regardless of your managerial position in life, you need to listen to others who may profit from your wisdom. Whether you are the CEO of a large corporation or a waiter serving food at the local bar and grill, Professor Rothberg's THE PERFECT MIX is a readable and an excellent way to learn some effective ways to understand your own position and responsibilities in the world of management.

There are many books (particularly on leadership) that give ADVICE. Rothberg does this in a way, like no other. From using examples from her bartending experience, her corporate experience and her wonderful recipes, Rothberg takes us on a journey that allows us to relate to experiences that we may encounter on our journey to being an authentic leader. There is a great twist though, literally! Each chapter has a great recipe with a breakdown of ingredients (as it relates to leadership). Brilliantly written and thought out.

This is a lightly humored book that has lovely teaching gems embedded within, especially from the bar. I recommend this book to new managers.
