Even I can't keep up with how quickly he goes. If you follow the pronunciation key in the book, you don't really need this CD. I don't feel that it added anything to my students' understanding of First Form Latin. Memoria Press needs to redo their CDs. The Latina Christiana one was also poorly done, and the speaker didn't even pronounce some things correctly.
