

First, there is little out there regarding Jewish history in the Carribean, so kudos to any book that explores that history. However, this book should really be called 'Some of the Sephardic Jews of Jamaica'. Though some general history is here, it really treats the story of the inter-related families

of the authors. Not much attention is paid to the Ashkenazi families or to those families who no longer practice Judaism. I also would like to have seen more treatment of the relations between the great Jewish families and their mixed race relatives, of which their are many. In short, this is a good over-view but that is all.

This is an excellent book to have in a home library for anyone doing research on Jews in Jamaica. It gave accurate details of some of the prominent Jews genealogy of Jamaica and history of the Portuguese/Spanish Jews. The only negative is not much is written about the Ashkenazi Jews, it is possible they were the minorities and most of their records were destroyed in earthquakes and hurricanes over the years.
