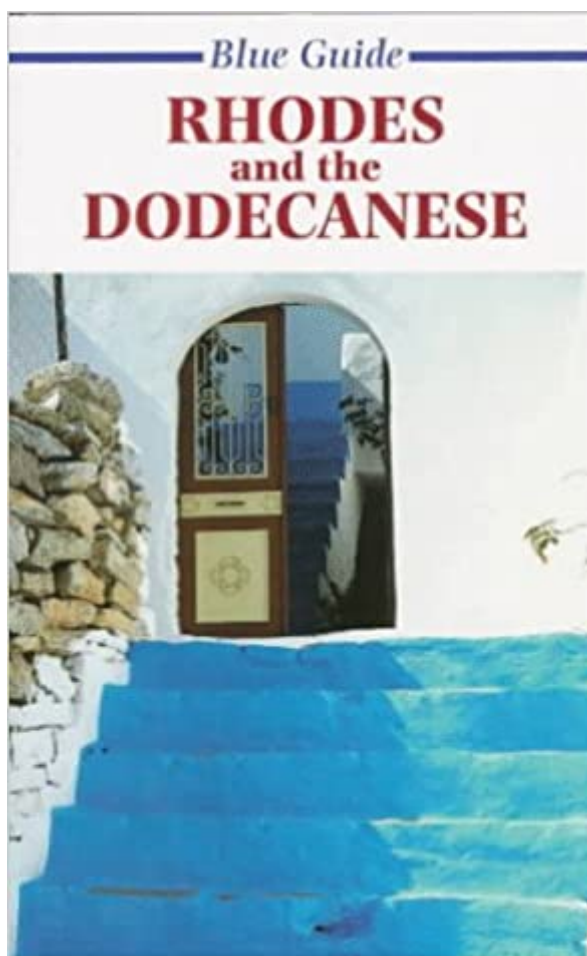


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# Blue Guide Rhodes And The Dodecanese (Blue Guides)
