

After booking a very expensive trip domestically, I remembered I added this book to my wishlist. I

purchased it (after the fact I know). That being said, it took me about an hour (less if I was not distracted) to read thru these very solid tips on exactly what sites to use to search and many tips and tricks to secure a flight. One thing I didn't know is that Federal Regulations allow me to cancel a trip within 24 hours without penalty! In theory, if I do find a better flight, I still have time to cancel. Who knew? I'd either have waited, not searched again or tried to change times and paid huge change fees. There's several other gems in this book that aren't well known. Or if they are, you're searching several blogs to find them and decipher if the information is correct. For \$5, it's a deal. There's no agenda to sell you anything. It's just solid useful actionable information you can use right away. At the very end, Scott goes thru a step by step in selection a trip. Exact methods. You could do the same thing for any trip you were going to fly anywhere in the world. Put the tips together as he does in the walk thru and you are bound to save money. For the record, on my expensive trip, using Scott's methods I could have saved over \$300 per ticket with his suggestions if I were a bit more flexible in my travel. Nonetheless, great book for the price. Will use it for sure to book the next trip.
